

## How to apply to the Religious Diversity and Anti-Discrimination Training Brussels April 10 - 15, 2011

If you wish to attend this training please do the following steps:

1. Complete the registration form and send it to [training@ceji.org](mailto:training@ceji.org) as soon as possible.  
**The deadline is September 13<sup>th</sup> 2010**
2. If you are accepted to the course you will be sent a certificate of acceptance.
3. If you are a school teacher you may apply for a mobility grant under the COMENIUS programme. If you are an adult educator, or work with adults, as a trainer, community worker or in some other capacity, you may apply for under the GRUNDTVIG programme.

- a) In order to apply for a grant you should contact your national agency: [http://ec.europa.eu/education/programmes/llp/national\\_en.html](http://ec.europa.eu/education/programmes/llp/national_en.html) and complete an application form, under either the COMENIUS or GRUNDTVIG programmes as appropriate..

- b) You should complete their application form and return it to the National Agency, by **September 15<sup>th</sup> 2010** together with the certificate of acceptance which we will send you. Take note that this deadline is strictly adhered to and that National Agencies do not consider late applications.

Please note that there is often a lot of competition for these grants so it is recommended that you take the time to make a good application in order to maximise the chances of your success.

- d) Your national agency will advise you if your application is accepted and you should contact us again with the outcome of the result in order to confirm your place on the course.
4. Whether you are self-paying or the recipient of a mobility grant, payment of the course fee is due two weeks before the start of the course.
5. You will receive further information about the training venue, and how to prepare for the training, two weeks before the training start date.
